Clarification of rs21 positions

Proposed by Taisie T, North London and amended at a National Meeting

- 1. The Steering Group will have eleven positions, which are elected by the National Meeting (NM) for a period of two NM intervals.
- 2. Of those positions, at least one should be a member from Scotland. If none is elected at the NM, the Steering Group will have a vacant position and will approach comrades in Scotland for a volunteer.
- 3. Five positions on the Steering Group are reserved for members who are not men. These will remain vacant if not taken up.
- 4. The Website Editor and the Assistant Website Editor are each elected for a period of one year (to the nearest NM).
- 5. The Organiser is elected for a period of one year (to the nearest NM). The Organiser role may be shared between two people.
- 6. The Website Editor will be an additional member of the Steering Group.
- 7. The Organiser will not be a member of the Steering Group but will attend its meetings and have a tie-breaking vote.
- 8. The Complaints Panel has twelve positions, which are elected by the NM for a year (to the nearest NM). Steering Group members and the Organiser cannot be on the Complaints Panel.
- 9. The Treasurer is appointed by the Steering Group.
