Using Workers Can Win as a political tool in rs21

Agreed at the February 2022 rs21 All Member Assembly

We are excited to see that Ian's book Workers Can Win: A guide to organising at work will be published by Pluto later this year, and think that this provides a brilliant opportunity for rs21 members.

Following on from what Ian outlined in his bulletin piece about the book, we have brought this motion as a way to set a path for how we use this opportunity.

As Ian noted, 'If comrades want to do this, it would require action by individual comrades, local groups and our industrial fractions – not just selling the book but building ongoing relationships with readers.' For that reason we propose:

- A members' meeting to discuss strategic options for using the book and its contents politically, identify priorities, and generate ideas
- That a working group be created to develop and pursue these ideas by organising workshops and trainings. The working group should also help rs21 branches and fractions to build political relationships with people organising at work, through delegations, visiting sites, and organising solidarity informed by Workers Can Win.
- That the rs21 organisers spend some of their paid hours supporting this working group and other political work of rs21 members around Workers Can Win.
