

The military takeover in Sudan under Gen. Burhan threatens to unravel the gains made by the democratic revolution of 2019. People across Sudan have taken to the streets to oppose the coup, with strikes and protests across the country, and hundreds of thousands coming out as part of a day of action on Saturday 30th October.

The mass resistance has been widely reported but the role of the different organisations inside the resistance - from the trade unions and political parties to the widespread neighbourhood committees, deserves further examination. The future of the revolution hangs in the balance, not just in terms of whether it can survive but what trajectory it will take if it does survive.
