FROM THE RIVER TO THE SEA PALESTINE WILL BE FREE

As Israel unleashes genocide on the people of Gaza, there has ever been a more important time to mobilise in solidarity with Pale ine.

More than 1,500 Palestinians have been murdered, and almost half a million displaced from their homes. Israel has cut off water, power, and food supply to Gaza, and ordered over a million people to leave their homes.

They have nowhere to go: Gaza is an open-air prison, and least has bombed the crossing into Egypt.

The responsibility for all civilian deaths, whether Participan or Israeli, lies with the Israeli state, its brutal architecture of apartheid and occurrence, and with its Western backers who have armed it to the teeth.

Here in Britain, both the Tories and Labour have stated their full and ongoing support for Israeli war crimes. The government has dispatched ships and ircraft to the region to support Israel's onslaught. At the same time, the government is cracking down on expressions of support for Palestine. The police have arrested an activist for wearing a Palestine flag and have threatened to arrest more.

The media is whipping up a witch hunt against people expressing solidarity with Palestine, while the government draws up plans to deport foreign sturents and workers who do so.

Socialist and anti-imperialists in Britain must stand against the edevelopments. As our ruling class seeks to turn public opinion against Palestine, we must oppose them, publicly and vocally. We must insist, against the media onslaught, on the right of Palestinians to resist a brutal occupation, and that the violence of the oppressor cannot be equated with the violence of the oppressed.
