Sunak, Braverman and Starmer are in panic and frozen. Braverman tried to make the police come for anyone chanting 'From the river to the sea. Palestine will be free!'. But the chant is rooted in a simple truth: freedom for the Palestinian people can only come with a single democratic state for all who live there.

Across the Middle East, from Baghdad to Cairo, millions are in the streets for Palestine. The imperialist ruling classes are terrified that this solidarity will ignite a new Arab **Spring**, where working people will liberate everyone in the region, bringing down the Israeli apartheid state and the Arab regimes that propit up.

Palestinian Resistance across the occupied territories is an inspiration to all of us. Palestinians are calling for our solidarity, and we need to keep showing it. We must respond to their call to disrupt the Israeli war machine and its political backers here in the West.

Whoever we are and wherever we are, we can do something to support Palestine. We have to demand that our MPs and councillors call for a ceasefire and work meaningfully to end the siege of Gaza. We should organise in our trade unions to support Palestine and agitate for an arms embargo against Israel.

The Palestinian struggle has sparked a new global movement. Their demand for freedom and justice is also a demand for a better world, for an alternative to war, oppression and capitalism. That better world is not only possible, it is necessary. The time to fight for it is now.
